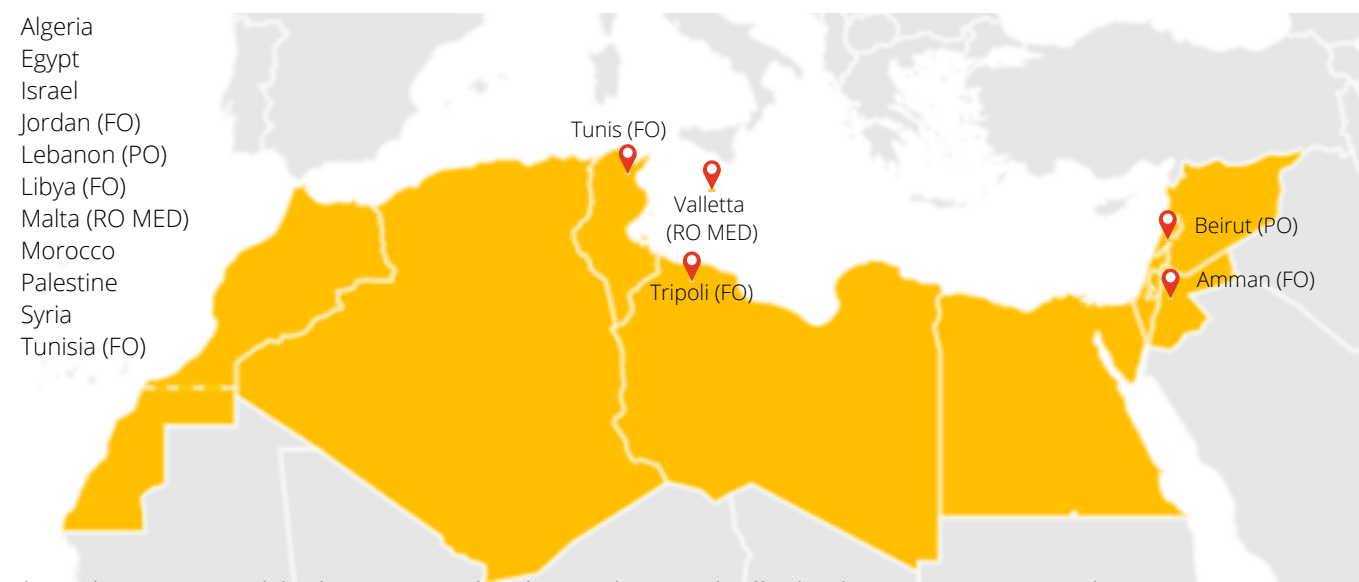

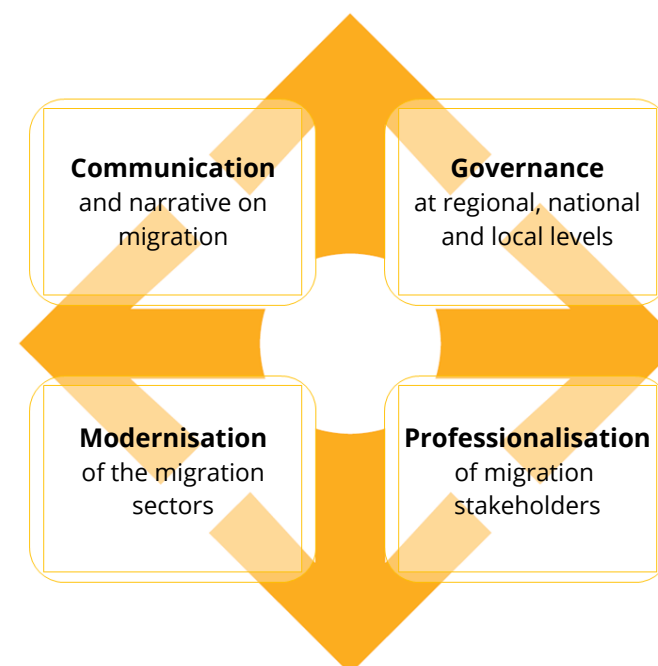
THE MEDITERRANEAN REGION

Regional Objectives

- Foster a capacity-centered approach to Migration Partnerships, promoting a vision of **joint leadership and shared responsibility**;
- Support the **professionalisation** of migration stakeholders by providing opportunities to develop and deliver quality-assured and accredited educational and vocational products and services;
- Put emphasis on multi-level **governance** to ensure evidence-driven, coherent, coordinated and sustainable migration policies and institutional reforms;
- Invest in the **modernisation** of the migration sectors in terms of infrastructures, equipment and services to improve operational capacities;
- Take action on evidence-driven narrative and **communication** across all migration sectors to increase impact.

Spotlight Achievements

Capitalising on the theme *re-defining Migration Partnerships* of the Maltese ICMPD Chair 2021 the region developed the Migration Capacity Partnership approach and translates its "drivers" into concrete actions to support the emergence of a new era of cooperation on migration in the region. Here are some highlights:

The flagship initiative of the Maltese Chair was launched in August 2021, namely the **Training Institute on Migration Capacity Partnership for the Mediterranean, MCP Med TI**.

- Regional migration governance programmes such as **EMM5**, **MC2CM** and **eMGPP**, as well as national programmes such as **ProGres Migration**, have delivered evidence and actionable results to address needs and challenges at regional, national and local levels of governance, and to breathe life into the call for renewed partnerships in the new EU Agenda for the Mediterranean.
- For instance, the **MC2CM days** (pictured below) under the patronage of the Committee of the Regions brought to light the advancements made in the inclusion of local authorities in the field of migration governance and management and the ways forward for meaningful and fruitful cooperation.
- Other initiatives included upgrading of operational capacities in Jordan through the procurement and installation of Stationary Heartbeat Detectors at 4 Border Crossing Points (BCPs) through the **IBM Jordan** project, as well as the installation of an integrated IT data solution for consolidating, managing, and analysing migration data from all relevant stakeholders through the **MIDAM** project.
- In Libya, the creation of a **National Platform of Civil Society Organisations** working on migration issues will offer support through the undertaking of capacity and needs assessments, provision of tailored coaching, as well as capacity enhancement through workshops and study visits on migration legislation, networking and engagement with Libyans abroad.



- The **Integrated Border Management (IBM) Tunisia Training Facility** achieved the construction of two interagency border management training centres for the benefit of the Tunisian agencies in charge of border management, in the Beja and Tozeur Governorates, contributing to the modernisation and professionalisation of migration sectors, including through the development of interagency border management training curricula.

Future Developments

- The Mediterranean region continues to be a laboratory of ideas, promoting innovation and spearheading the development of timely and relevant initiatives. As way of example, a notable initiative addressing identified needs of the sector is in development, namely on the **mobility of health workers in the region in partnership with the World Health Organization (WHO)**.
- Moreover, additional concrete actions under the **Migration Capacity Partnership approach** are being developed.
- Additionally, the ICMPD in the Mediterranean will work closely with France in 2022 in the field of narratives and **communication** in various migration sectors.
