ICMPD has a long lasting cooperation with Ukraine, which in 1995 was formalised in a form of a trilateral cooperation agreement and materialised in a number of bi- and multilateral projects. The commitment was renewed in 2019: ICMPD signed the two important agreements on cooperation with Ukrainian migration and border management authorities which paved the way for even closer cooperation. Ukraine is an active participating state in two Migration Dialogues – the Prague and Budapest Processes, to which ICMPD serves as a Secretariat.
