
### **MIGRATION DRIVERS, FACTORS AND MEGATRENDS**

#### **DEMOGRAPHY**

The world population is expected to grow to 9.7 billion by 2050. However, 45 - mainly European - countries are projected to witness declining populations between 2009 and 2050

More than 65% of persons aged 60 or above live in the global South

In absence of functioning pension systems migration is a means to secure livelihoods of elderly family members




#### **URBANISATION**

The share of the world population living in cities is expected to grow in the future

International migrants have often moved internally before

The degree of urbanisation influences international migration



#### **CLIMATE CHANGE & ENVIRONMENTAL MIGRATION**

The impact of environmental changes increases. Low and middle income countries are most affected

Climate change is a 'stress multiplier' that exacerbates pre-existing conditions

There is no commonly accepted definition of 'climate refugees' or 'environmental migrants'

By 2050:

Estimate of 20 environmental migrants (range of forecasts: 25m-1bn)

2016:

24.2m new internal displacements caused by disasters

#### **INTERNATIONAL MIGRATION**


The share of international migrants among the world population remains relatively stable: 2.5-3.5%

The total number of international migrants is 272 million and increases with world population growth

#### **INCOME DISPARITIES**

Income gaps between the world regions increase. This furthers international migration

#### SOCIO-ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT

Wages and educational levels increase; birth rates and mortalities decrease


