





# 1- Dialogue Component: Peer-Learning events

#### **MC2CM Peer-Learning events:**

> Thematic learning events – themes selected by cities based on their priorities

#### **Structure:**

- A Background document to set the common understanding
- Meetings structure:
  - > Definition of the common challenges & opportunities
  - > Local solutions: cases presentation from participants
  - > Field visit proposed by the host city
  - > Identification of recommendations by the participants
- > A thematic learning note to capture & capitalize the results


