Capacity Development

The ultimate goal of the actions envisaged under this component is to equip Georgian state institutions working in the field of migration with theoretical knowledge and practical skills for mainstreaming migration-related priorities and matters into the development and implementation of migration policies as well as researching and forecasting migration processes.

Civil Society Facility

The Civil Society Facility (CSF) aims to engage civil society organizations in a substantive dialogue concerning the impact of migration and mobility on the Georgia's development processes. The CSF endeavors to bolster the networking, communication, and capacities of civil society organizations (CSOs), enabling them to actively participate in maximizing the positive impact of migration on development.
