TSI FLAGSHIP 2026

Timeframe:

31 October 2025 – Deadline to submit request
Q2 2026 – Start of technical support



Coordination with TSI National Coordinating Authorities is mandatory



Country-specific recommendations of European Semester are even more important



TSI FLAGSHIP 2026



Multi-country requests

- **MS are encouraged to submit such requests**
- Careful selection by SG Reform

TSI FLAGSHIP 2026



Requests must be:

- **Well-defined, feasible** and **specific**, tied to national priorities
- Justified with **evidence of inability to deliver internally**
- Supported by **political backing** (e.g. coalition agreements)
- Accompanied by a clear follow-up plan based on **past TSI engagement**

Evaluation will focus on:

- **Quality** of submission
- **Government commitment** and **follow-through**
- **Tangible outcomes** and **results**, not just deliverables and activities

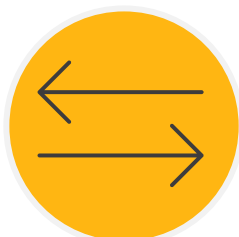
